2022 Q4 Japan Summary by Otoha Hayashi (Chair of Int'l Committee)

There were 3 local conferences held in this quarter across Japan, combined with the Young Speech Competition qualifying sessions.

As Japan is still under a stricter COVID-19 protocol than other countries due to the government's order, some clubs had faced a great difficulty in arranging a suitable venue in advance, if not met with the lack of support from their own members. At the same time, some hosting clubs were still incapable to find a venue that was capable to support them in hosting a hybrid event, therefore resorted to only host completely offline while gravely limiting the number of participants allowed on the day. The differences in each local club and the area's technological skills/abilities has impacted the number of participants gravely, which we are hoping to have resolved in 2023, when the government is planning to ease the COVID-19 protocol.
